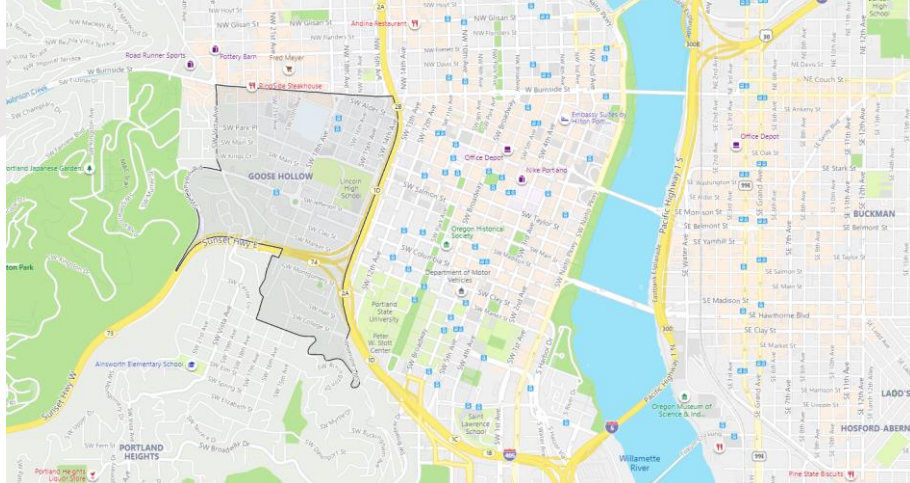

Goose Hollow is home to 6507 people in 4194 households:

- ✦ PSU housing

2000 new residential units have been approved by the city and/or are planned for Goose Hollow, which would increase our population by up to 35% in the next five years

Goose Hollow Has Always Been a Working-Class Neighborhood

Goose Hollow ranks 88th out of 102 neighborhoods by median household income and is one of its most racially diverse

- ✦ we are a true urban neighborhood of 80% renters, with half of these low-income, 15% in subsidized housing, and 21% on food stamps
